



Did You Know:

- The Madison County Child Advocacy Center completed 481 interviews in 2011 related to allegations of child sexual and severe physical abuse.
- The Child Advocacy Centers' multidisciplinary team approach minimizes the number of times a child must talk about his or her abuse, which greatly reduces the child's trauma.
- Annual investigation costs per 1,000 victimized children are 41% lower in communities with a Child Advocacy Center compared to communities that do not.
